## *Who can use it?*

All Durham, Middlefield and Rockfall residents with proof of residency and purchased sticker on windshield (\$50 and available on site. Renewable annually on July 1.)

Detergent bottles  
Empty aerosol cans  
Plastic buckets

Please rinse all containers  
No food waste  
No buckets or containers  
larger than 5 gallons

## *ELECTRONICS RECYCLING*

Such as: televisions, computers, cell phones, monitors, modems, printers, stereos, DVD & CD players, video games, LED bulbs & fluorescent bulbs. Limit 3 items per visit.

## *ALSO ACCEPTABLE*

Scrap metal, motor and waste oil (oil only; no solvents), antifreeze, ashes, mattresses, box springs, household & automotive batteries, leaves (must be removed from bags in designated area)

## *COMPOST YOUR WASTE!!!*

You can drop off food scraps for recycling at the Transfer Station. For a full list of what you can recycle and how to obtain a food scrap recycling kit go to [townofdurhamct.org](http://townofdurhamct.org) or [middlefieldct.org](http://middlefieldct.org).

## *NO, NO..*

The transfer station does not accept: grass, brush larger than 4" in diameter or 8' in length, clean fill, hazardous wastes such as lead or oil based paints or stains, asbestos, gasoline and other motor fuels, solvents, pesticides or herbicides (Look for Hazardous waste collection days online at [townofdurhamct.org](http://townofdurhamct.org) or [middlefieldct.org](http://middlefieldct.org).)

**G** COMPOST PILE FOR LEAVES  
(LEAVES MUST BE TAKEN OUT OF BAGS; NO GRASS)

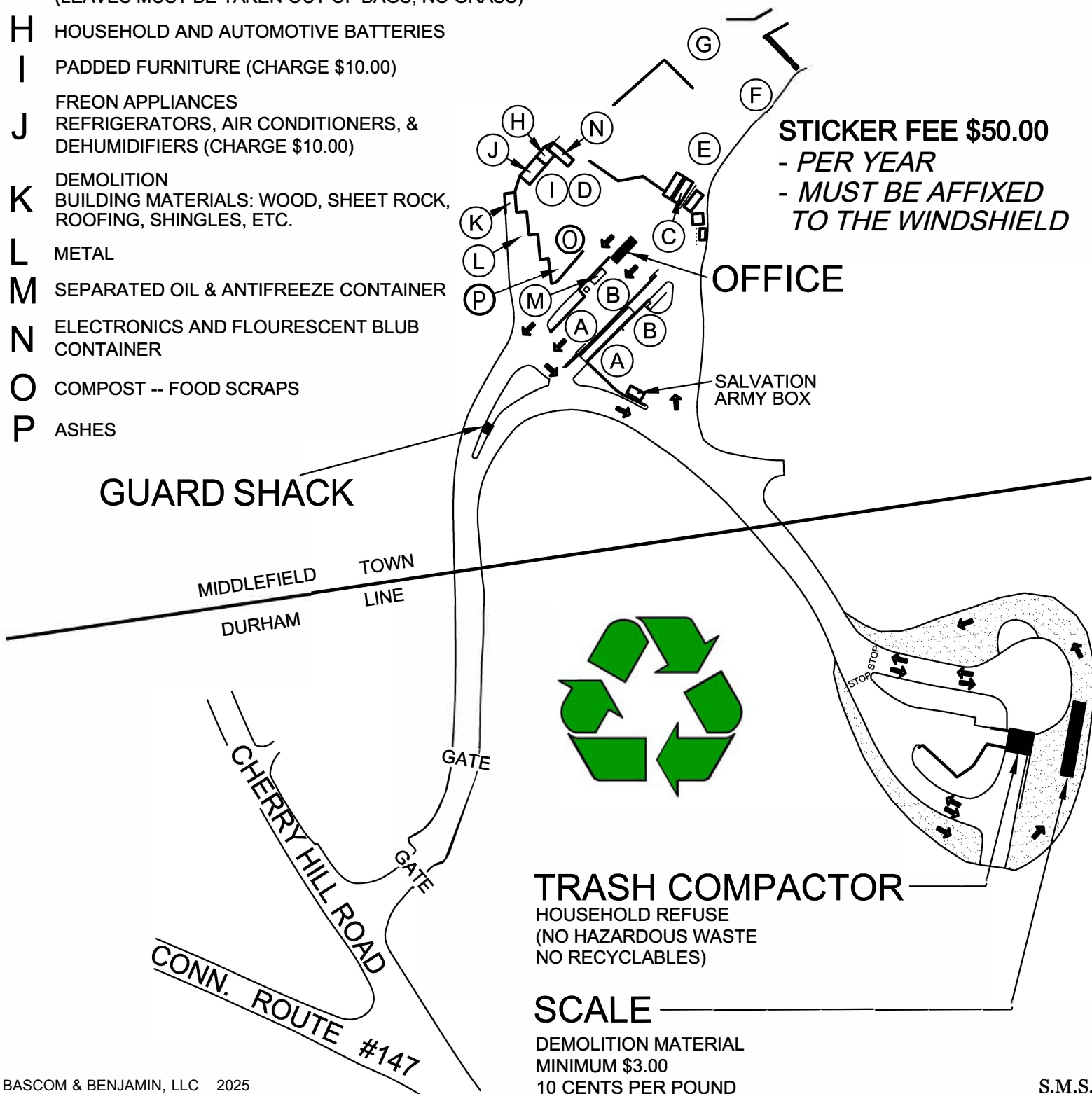
