A pilot program is now under way to make it easier for you to compost your waste at home. Yard composters will be available to purchase but supplies are limited. ### NO, NO..

The transfer station does not accept: brush larger than 4" in diameter or 8' in length, clean fill, hazardous wastes such as lead or oil based paints or stains, asbestos, gasoline and other motor fuels, solvents, fluorescent light bulbs, pesticides or herbicides (Look for Hazardous waste collection days in the town times or online at [www.townofdurhamct.org](http://www.townofdurhamct.org).)

### NEW CHARGE AS OF JULY 1, 2012:

All commercial haulers and landscapers will be charged for brush at the rate of 2 cents per pound; \$40 per ton.

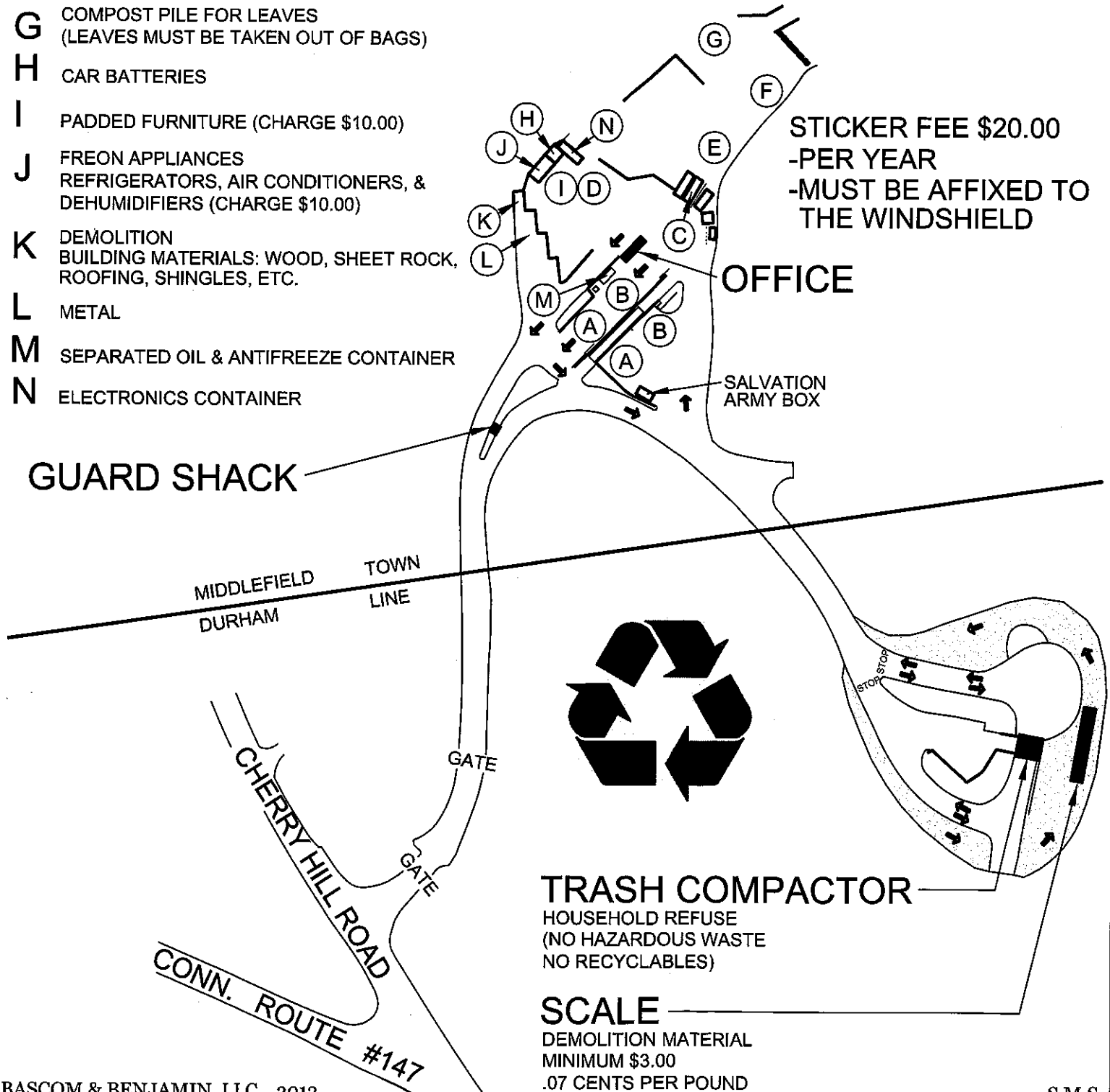

- D** MATTRESSES AND BOX SPRING (CHARGE \$10.00 A PIECE)
- E** WOOD CHIPS FREE TO TAKE
- F** BRUSH PILE NOTHING OVER 4" IN DIAMETER AND 8' IN LENGTH. NO STUMPS CONTRACTORS .02 CENTS PER POUND
- G** COMPOST PILE FOR LEAVES (LEAVES MUST BE TAKEN OUT OF BAGS)
- H** CAR BATTERIES
- I** PADDED FURNITURE (CHARGE \$10.00)
- J** FREON APPLIANCES REFRIGERATORS, AIR CONDITIONERS, & DEHUMIDIFIERS (CHARGE \$10.00)
- K** DEMOLITION BUILDING MATERIALS: WOOD, SHEET ROCK, ROOFING, SHINGLES, ETC.
- L** METAL
- M** SEPARATED OIL & ANTIFREEZE CONTAINER
- N** ELECTRONICS CONTAINER
